The Department of Sociology and Legal Studies at the University of Waterloo invites applications for a tenure-track position at the Assistant Professor level to start on or after July 1, 2012. The department is seeking someone with advanced training in quantitative methods and statistics. Applicants should have a PhD in Sociology or they must have completed a PhD by July 1, 2012. The substantive areas of research are open. The department is particularly interested in building its resources in one of the following areas: criminology and legal studies, the sociology of education, or work, occupations and organizations. A commitment to teaching the required undergraduate and graduate courses in statistics and research methods is required.

The University of Waterloo is a research intensive institution, as is the Department of Sociology and Legal Studies. It has a close affiliation with the Southwest Ontario Research Data Centre and the Survey Research Centre at the university. Candidates will be expected to contribute actively to the well- established graduate program in Sociology (MA and PhD), and the working relationship with these two research centres.

A complete application, including a covering letter, curriculum vitae, a representative sample of academic writing, and the names and contact information for three referees should be sent to the address given below. Candidates also are encouraged to submit teaching dossiers and evaluations. All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however Canadians and permanent residents will be given priority. The University of Waterloo encourages applications from all qualified individuals, including women, members of visible minorities, native peoples, and persons with disabilities. The closing date for applications is January 31, 2012.

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
